



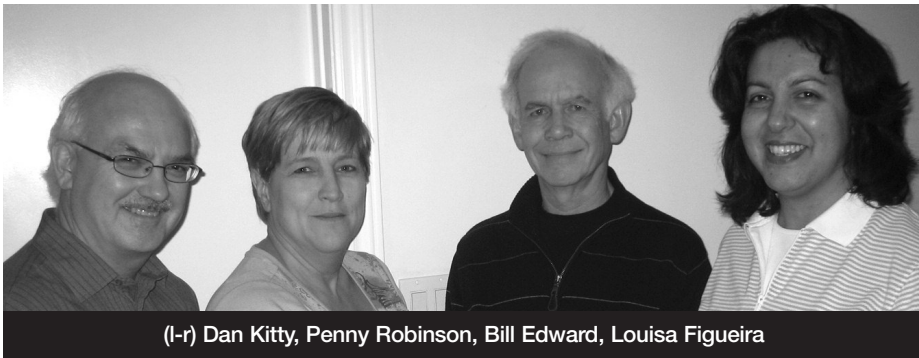

Opening Day is Saturday April 30th this year. Please join us for a free barbecue and have some fun playing tennis.

It's that happy time of year again when you can take out your tennis racquet and look ahead to the nice tennis weather. So now is the time to renew your Wishing Well Tennis Club membership.

All our membership fees are the same as last year. Join by opening day on April 30 and get the early-bird adult rate of \$60. After April 30 membership goes up to \$65; pay by April 30 and save \$5. Guest fees are \$5 per person; you may bring the same guest 3 times. The guest fee is payable to any executive member, coach or team captain at the courts.

Your membership fees cover the club expenses for permit fees to the City of Toronto, court maintenance, nets, resurfacing, newsletters, signage, new wind-

creens and so on. The club also has to pay a fee for every member (including children this year for the first time) to the Scarborough Tennis Federation, which in turn pays a portion of that to the Ontario Tennis Association.

> Casual Mondays

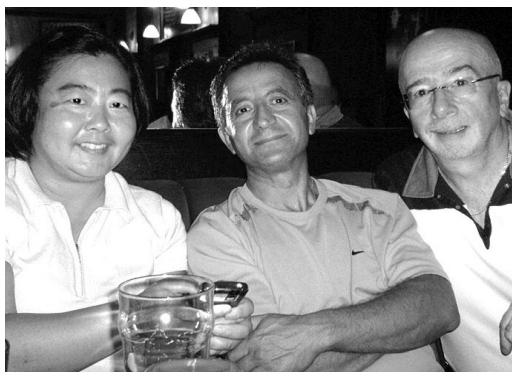
This will operate the same as last year and is open to all members. All you have to do is show up and someone will organize partners.

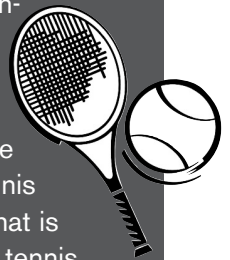
